I understand that being at Smarte I will:

1) Be respectful with my words and action towards everyone

-Everyone at Smarte is expected to use appropriate language which includes not using swear words, making fun of other people nor hurting other people physically or emotionally.

2) Take care of Smarte Supplies by putting things away after I'm done and using equipment in a safe way

-Everyone is expected to keep track of the outdoor equipment as well as the supplies inside. They are expected to put away what they used and to use the equipment for what it is intended. Ex: markers are used for coloring, not sword fighting.

3) Be responsible for my own stuff and make sure I have everything I need coming to Smarte and leaving Smarte

-Everyone is responsible for his/her own stuff. This includes putting things away in their backpack and keeping track of their homework and not leaving out. This also means that they take home their lunch bags and water bottles.

4) Be truthful in what I say

-Everyone is expected to tell the truth.

5) Always ask before leaving the Smarte area inside or the quad.

-Everyone is expected to let a teacher know where they are going. If they are leaving our line of sight they need to bring a buddy with them. If the student cannot be located, Smarte staff will call

home immediately and the student will remain indoors until pick up time. In addition, each student must check in with a staff member 15 minutes after school dismissal. Failure to do so will result in a phone call home.

6) Work my hardest on the homework I have and ask for help when I need help

-Everyone must try their best on the homework they have. This includes filling out the homework log truthfully and trying their best on each assignment. If they need help they are expected to ask for help.

7) Let a staff know when I need help with a person

-Everyone is expected to come to a teacher when they need help working things out with a peer. The staff will do everything necessary to make sure a situation is resolved.

8) Include everyone

-Everyone that wants to be involved in a group game will be. "You can't say you can't play" applies to Smarte.

9) Be safe with my body and other people's physical space

-Everyone is expected to maintain appropriate space. **Physical aggression is never tolerated at Smarte and they will be sent home immediately and not be able to return the next day if they hurt another child.**

10) Participate in games and activities

-Everyone is expected to participate in Smarte run activities like Friday Games or Team Challenges.
